Archangels, Atonement, and the Light We Seek

As the leaves begin to turn and the air carries the first whispers of the Fall season, we as Scottish Rite Masons find ourselves in a season rich with spiritual significance. September and October are months when both the Christian and Jewish calendars invite us to pause, reflect, and realign ourselves with the divine purpose that supports our Masonic journey.

The Feast of the Archangels: Guardians of Divine Order

On September 29th, many Christians celebrate the Feast of the Archangels - Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. These celestial beings are more than mythic figures; they are symbols of divine justice, healing, and revelation. Michael, the protector and warrior, reminds us of our duty to defend truth. Gabriel, the messenger, calls us to speak with clarity and compassion. Raphael, the healer, urges us to mend what is broken within ourselves and in the world.

In the Scottish Rite, particularly within the Chapter of Rose Croix, we speak often of the balance between justice and mercy, strength and beauty. The Archangels embody these virtues. As Prelate, I see their presence not as doctrine, but as symbols that inspire our moral compasses and illuminate our path towards wisdom.

High Holy Days: Atonement and Renewal

In the Jewish tradition, this season is marked by the High Holy Days - Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Rosh Hashanah, the Jewish New Year, is a time of reflection and hope. Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement, is a solemn call to repentance, forgiveness, and spiritual renewal. Though Freemasonry is not a religion, it is deeply spiritual. The Scottish Rite teaches us to examine our actions, seek reconciliation, and strive toward the perfection of character and spirituality. The themes of the High Holy Days resonate with our own rituals of purification and moral elevation. We, too, are called to weigh our deeds and renew our commitment to the Great Architect of the Universe.

The Masonic Parallel: Light in Darkness

In our degrees, especially those of the Knight Rose Croix (18°), we explore the triumph of light over darkness, of virtue over vice. This mirrors the spiritual arc of both the Celestial feast and the Jewish high holy days. Whether through the trumpet of Gabriel or the shofar of Rosh Hashanah, we are summoned to awaken - to rise from spiritual slumber and pursue the Light.

Let us, as Brothers, embrace this season not merely as a calendar shift, but as a sacred opportunity. Let us reflect on the angels who guard our conscience, the rituals that cleanse our soul, and the eternal truths that bind us together as Scottish Rite Masons.

May the blessings of this season guide your steps, renew your spirit, and deepen your commitment to the sublime teachings of our Rite and to the Supreme Architect of the Universe.

The Feast of Tishri

Monday, October 13th, the Valley of Tampa Scottish Rite Bodies will have an open meeting during which Ill. Gil Weisman, 33° will deliver a presentation about the Feast of Tishri.

The book of Leviticus tells us that the Feast of Tishri (also known as the Feast of the Tabernacle and/ or The Feast of Succoth) was started when God commanded Moses that, "...in the fifteenth day of the seventh month when ye shall have gathered the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the Lord seven days."

It was initially a harvest or gathering festival and a time to give thanks. This feast, still observed during the time of King Solomon and to coincide with it, he timed the dedication of the Temple. As Scottish Rite Masons, we consider it obligatory observance under the Statutes of the Supreme Council —sharing of our fraternal spirit and a reaffirmation of our dedication to the principles of the Scottish Rite.









MEMBER EDUCATION & DIRECTOR OF WORK

Illustrious Richard A. Vogt, 33°

I want to start off by congratulating all those Brothers who were selected to receive the 33rd Degree and those selected for Knight Commander Court of Honor investiture.

Well Done, My Brothers!

These Brothers have achieved this recognition due to their outstanding, and continuing, service to the Scottish Rite and the Valley of Tampa in particular. I remind you all of this because we have begun having full reunions again twice a year, as well as Masonic Education at each of our Consistory meetings. The Reunions in particular require a great many Brothers to participate in the Degrees, sound and lighting, wardrobe, and stage and prop setup and takedown. Masonic Education each month requires knowledgeable Brothers to share that knowledge with their fellow Brethren. As the Fall Reunion is approaching, I have already had a couple of Degree Masters tell me they can't be ready for lack of participation in the Degree. I had to cancel three degrees in the Spring for the same reason. It might sound like I am venting, but I am not. I am pleading for your help. I have two or three Degrees now in need of a Degree Master. And at least six Degrees that need cast members. Remember when you sat in the chairs as a new candidate, and you saw a multitude of Brothers give forth of their time so you could enjoy the Degrees and become a Master of the Royal Secret. Please think about paying it forward.

We have been going through the various bodies of the Consistory and now we end with a look at the Consistory Degrees themselves. The Consistory Degrees are the 31st and 32nd. They are very different from any of the previous Degrees with the 32nd Degree being a culmination and recap of all that went before. But before we get there, we have the 31st Degree-Inspector Inquisitor. You have met the Inquisitors in a previous Degree, but these Inquisitors are actually the gods of Ancient Egypt. They will decide if the candidate is morally qualified to be received into the eternal light. This Degree reveals the dynamic relationship that has existed for centuries between human law as a means of obtaining justice and the divine justice as an ideal. We are required in this Degree to judge ourselves in the light of this knowledge and lessons we learned in all of the preceding Degrees. Immortality requires more than an outward appearance of piety. It requires the moral rectitude of a Masonic heart—Do you remember where you were first made a Mason?

The 32nd Degree is the culmination of all the Scottish Rite Degrees. It takes us through a review of the Lodge of Perfection, the Chapter of Rose Croix, and the Council of Kadosh. We learn the very ancient roots of Masonic Truth. The Royal Secret is divulged and explained and becomes the capstone of Scottish Rite instruction. From this fundamental truth is derived human wisdom and the virtue of right conduct. That wisdom and right conduct that will enable your entrance into Eternal Light.
